







#### TREE PLANTATION AT PAKSHITEERTH & WEEKLY MEETING

05 JUL 2023



The Tree Plantation Project at Pakshiteerth in Vikaswadi, 5 Star MIDC, witnessed an enthusiastic participation of 23 Rotary members and 7 Rotaractors under the Community Service Avenue. Together, they planted 27 trees, symbolizing their commitment to environmental conservation. The event featured a distinguished guest speaker, Dr. Madhukar Bachulkar-Cholekar, who enlightened the attendees on the importance of changing our approach to nature to ensure its preservation for future generations.





Dr. Madhukar Bachulkar-Cholekar, a botanist and expert on wild plants, especially in the Western ghats, has been working for environmental conservation and protection for the past many years. In his speech he initially emphasized the importance of the Western ghats in our country where more than 650 varieties of plants are found. These ghats covering 6 States of India are 1600 km long and occupy 5% of the Indian territory. But after 75 years of independence only 37% of the forest in this area is remaining now. He credited this to the tourism and human interference resulting in climate change which leads to global warming and eventually to destruction of life on the planet. He very strongly criticized the use of chemical fertilizers encouraged by the green revolution and the pollution of air, water and land because of it. The ideal forest cover required in the country being 33%, we now have only 8% of dense forest left in India. This can be corrected by planting native trees instead of foreign plants as they would survive naturally and help provide shelter and food for native animals and birds. He advised everyone to come together and ensure the survival of forests, preserve biodiversity and ensure a peaceful happy future.



The club organized a Blood donation camp at LG Branch Office Kolhapur, under the community service avenue in 6th July 2023.

Rtn. Mahendrabhai Parmar and Rtn. Amol Ghodake were present at the camp. We collected total 30 pints of blood.






#### Rtn. Sachin Anuje


