
PDG ANAND KULKARNI VISIT TO RSSK

Dr. Kulkarni emphasized the increasing marriage age due to career-oriented women and advised checking Anti-Mullerian Hormone levels in their twenties for potential egg preservation.

17 JULY 2024

WEEKLY MEETING

Kulkarni, a Sachin Dr. renowned gynecologist, introduced by Rtn. Shobha Arvind, presented a study on diet's role in managing PCOS. He highlighted that junk food consumption can lead to obesity, menstruation and causing menstrual irregularities. He recommended a gluten-free diet, suggesting bajra and ragi roti, and praised the Prime Minister's promotion of millets.



He explained that the menopausal age for Indian women is 47.5, lower than in other countries, and clarified that early menstruation is not genetically linked. He stressed the importance of HPV vaccination to prevent cervical cancer and discussed cord blood preservation costs.

He clarified doubts about ectopic pregnancy and warned about hormonal changes due to high fertilizer use in potato production. He also discussed sperm preservation for men undergoing chemotherapy for testicular cancer, suggesting IVF for future parenthood.

Dr. Kulkarni's talk covered critical aspects of reproductive health and scientific advancements. The vote of thanks was given by Rtn. Sunita Goenka, who was also congratulated for being the lucky Rotarian of the week.




AVENUES OF SERVICE AWARD

RECIPES FROM THE PAST

Sindhi Kadhi



Ingredients:

Oil. 4 TBSP Cumin seeds. 1 TSP Mustard seeds. 1 TSP Fenugreek seeds. 1/2 TSP Asafoetida. 1/4 TSP Gram flour. 6 TBSP Curry leaves. 1 SPRIG Hot water. 1.5 Litre

Turmeric powder. 1/2 TSP

Kashmiri red chilli powder 1 TSP

Green chilli. 2 no.(Slits)

Tomato. 3 Drumstick. 1

Cluster beans. 1/2 cup

Potato. 3 Oil. 1 TBSP

Lady finger. 10-12

Salt

Tamarind pulp

Method:

Set a stock pot over heat and once it gets hot add in the oil and heat it well.

Once the oil gets hot add cumin seeds, mustard seeds, Fenugreek seeds and asafoetida (stir well).

Further add the gram flour, stir and cook over low flame until the gram flour turns biscuity in colour (stir continuously).

Once the gram flour turns biscuity, add curry leaves, once they crackle add hot water and stir it, make sure that no lumps remain.

Then add the remaining water along with salt, turmeric powder, kashmiri red chilli powder, green chilli and stir it well to bring the kadhi to boil.(5 mins)

While it is boiling, set a pan over high heat add oil into it and once the oil gets hot add the lady finger and fry them over medium high flame for 3-4 mins and transfer into a bowl. (Do the same for the brinjals too).

Now take another pot and add tomato puree in it and add drumstick, cluster beans, potato, coliflower and now stir it for 5 mins.

Now put this into the biscuity coloured kadhi.

Then keep it at low flame for 20 mins.

After 20 mins add the lady finger, brinjal and the tamarind pulp and stir it well for 10 mins.

Once cooked, check the potato for its doneness, it should be cooked if not then continue to cook until they become soft.

Taste and add salt if needed.




