






resolution for bifurcating the district was passed.




# 05 FEB 2025 WEEKLY MEETING






### **ACHIEVEMENTS CORNER**

### **GLOBAL ROTARY AT A GLANCE**

#### 4 WAY TEST IS THE MOST WIDELY QUOTED STATEMENTS OF BUSINESS ETHICS IN THE WORLD

**Herbert J. Taylor** was the one who Formulated the 4 Way Test in 1932 when he took charge of a Company that was facing Bankruptcy. He was a **Rotarian from Chicago** who later went up to become the RI President in 1954-55.

- He created this as a 24-word Code of Ethics for all his employees to follow in their Business and Professional Lives.
- The 4 Way Test was adopted by Rotary in 1943 and has translated into more than a Hundred Languages and published Thousands of ways.
