RI Board Adopts New Zones Structure



Every Rotary year, the Rotary International Board of Directors makes minor changes to the list of zones based on decisions to merge or create new districts, or grant district requests to change zones. In addition, the Board conducts a comprehensive review at least every eight years to comply with RI Bylaws that districts and clubs be divided into 34 zones of approximately equal number of Rotarians. This is done to ensure that Rotary's Board of Directors accurately reflects our diverse and global membership.

In 2025, three Board-approved regional workgroups developed rezoning proposals for Asia, Europe/Africa, and the Americas. These workgroups submitted their proposals to the Zones Review Steering Committee, chaired by RI Vice President Alain Van de Poel, which consolidated them into a single, worldwide plan for the Board's consideration at their January 2026 meeting. The Board voted unanimously to approve this plan.

The Board will consider other zone-related issues such as sectioning, pairing, and director election rotation at its April 2026

meeting. Zones in Indian subcontinent will be as under -

Zone 4 - India (western): 3030, 3040, 3060, 3131, 3132, 3141, 3142, 3172

Zone 5 - India (southern), Maldives, Sri Lanka: 2981, 2982, 3000, 3203, 3206, 3212, 3220, 3231, 3233, 3234

Zone 6 - Bhutan, India (eastern and northeastern), Nepal: 3100, 3110, 3120, 3240, 3250, 3261, 3262, 3291, 3292

Zone 7 - India (southern): 3020, 3150, 3160, 3171, 3181, 3182, 3191, 3192, 3204, 3205, 3211

Zone 8 - India (north and northwest), Russia: 2223, 3011, 3012, 3053, 3055, 3056, 3070, 3080, 3090

Kolhapur Zilla Sahakari Dudh Utpadak Sangh Ltd.

Kolhapur Zilla Sahakari Dudh Utpadak Sangh Ltd., popularly known by its trusted brand 'Gokul', is one of Maharashtra's leading cooperative dairy institutions. Established on **16th March 1963** under the **Operation Flood**



movement, Gokul has grown into a model cooperative, empowering thousands of milk producers and setting benchmarks in procurement, processing, animal health, and dairy product marketing.

Over the decades, Gokul has achieved remarkable milestones across all aspects of the dairy sector. Today, it operates a **modern dairy plant with a capacity of 17 lakh litres per day**, along with a **satellite dairy at Udgaon (Taluka Shirol)** and **four company-owned chilling centres**, together handling **8 lakh litres of milk per day**. The organization also runs a **state-of-the-art packaging unit at Navi Mumbai** to serve wider markets efficiently.

To strengthen milk production across its milk shed, Gokul has established a robust support network, including **46 mobile veterinary service routes** and **260 cluster-based Artificial Insemination centres**, ensuring better animal health, breeding, and productivity for farmers.

In the field of cattle nutrition, Gokul operates a **modern 450 MT/day cattle feed plant** at the **Kagal-Hatkanangale Five Star MIDC**, producing the popular 'Mahalaxmi' brand feed since March 2011. This is complemented by the **200 MT/day capacity plant at Mudshingi (Taluka Karveer)**, which continues to function efficiently.

With technical support from **NDDB**, Gokul also launched a **Total Mixed Ration (TMR) project** with a capacity of **50 MT/day** at the Mudshingi plant in December 2018, further enhancing dairy productivity.

Demonstrating its commitment to sustainability, Gokul initiated a **Manure Management Project** in 2022 with a capacity of **5 MT/day**, utilizing inputs from **120 flexi biogas units**. This eco-friendly initiative has been implemented with the support of **Sustain Plus Energy Foundation (Tata Trusts)** and **NDDB**, promoting renewable energy and scientific waste management in the dairy sector.

With its strong farmer base, advanced infrastructure, and forward-looking initiatives, **Gokul continues to be a symbol of cooperative success, rural empowerment, and dairy excellence in Maharashtra and beyond.**
